



There are 29 Pocket one bedroom homes and a gorgeous shared roof terrace. It has a striking brick and glazed façade offering:



- Plenty of secure cycle storage for everyone who needs it





# Rosina Street E9 The neighbourhood

Rosina Street E9 is in a great location in the borough of Hackney, just a few minutes walk from Homerton station and Homerton High Street. Just down the road one way is bustling Hackney Central and the other buzzing Hackney Wick, both have a wide range of restaurants, shops and cafes. Here are some of our nearby favourites:

#### 1. Hatch 🗹

A super cool little café and bar that hosts a variety of events as well as hot desks and a barber.

#### 2. Jackdaw and Star $\ensuremath{\mathbb{Z}}$

This local favourite serves craft beers and slow-cooked meats in multi-layered sandwiches as well as a top notch Sunday roast.

#### 3. Sutton House & Breakers Yard 🗹

An unexpected Tudor gem, this National Trust property is well worth a visit to relax in the courtyard and discover its diverse history, which includes squatters taking residence in the 1980s!

#### 4. Triangle 🗹

Triangle is Pocket's favourite independent retailer of mid-century furniture as well as curated accessories, ceramics and clothes.

#### 5. Brooksby's Walk 🗹

An eccentric restaurant occupying a former a public toilet, Brooksby's Walk serves up well priced gourmet food in an unforgettable environment.

#### 6. Well Street Common 🗹

Nestled next to the well known Victoria Park, this patch of green is the ideal spot to catch some rays.

#### 7. Well's Butchers 🗹

This third generation family butchers was established in 1931, the perfect place to get high quality local meat.

#### 8. Olympic Park 🗹

As well as the impressive selection of sporting facilities, head to the Olympic Park to get your dose of retail therapy or just grab a coffee.

#### 9. Fish Island $\square$

The artistic community has been based here for many years, making it the perfect place to take in an exhibition and grab a bite to eat.

#### 10. Hackney Marshes 🗹


Known as the spiritual home of Sunday league football, this sporting mecca also has a café and terrace.


