### Mapleton Crescent SW18 The building

Designed by architects Metropolitan Workshop, the slender 27-storey building has striking green glazed-terracotta tiles. Arranged around a unique triangular core, some of the homes overlook the gently flowing River Wandle while others offer panoramic views across London. There are 53 one bedroom Pocket homes on floors 1 to 11 (with 36 two and three bedroom open market Pocket Edition homes higher up).

#### 1. The Dynamo 🖄

This cyclist hangout is best known for its sourdough pizzas and great coffee. Serving up amazing breakfasts too, it's always packed with locals in lycra.

#### 2. The Putney Canteen 🖾

Known for its generous portions and decent prices, this neighbourhood café has offers on throughout the week.

#### 3. Wandsworth Park 🗹

This historic park is a great green space with a leafy promenade along the Thames loved by local fitness fiends and families alike.

#### 4. The Cat's Back 🗹

This tiny Victorian pub, set back from the river, stocks a solid collection of beer with seasonal varieties on rotation. Complete with a roaring fire and leafy patio, it's a year-round favourite.

#### 5. Dutch Courage 🗹

A fun and friendly neighbourhood bar with live music on the weekends.

#### 6. Aurienna Caribbean Cookhouse 🗹

Putney

'Arrive hungry, leave happy'. Living up to its tagline, this authentic restaurant serves great food with a real slice of island hospitality.

#### 7. The Black Chapel 🗹

Amazing vintage espresso bar, a paradise for die-hard coffee drinkers.

#### 8. Southside Shopping Centre 🗹

A huge complex with cinemas, gyms and a great range of shops, cafés, restaurants and more.

#### 9. King George's Park 🖄

This lovely park is right on the doorstep of Mapleton Crescent SW18. It has everything from pretty gardens and a lake to tennis courts and other sports facilities for hire.

#### 10. Café Fleur 🗹

East Putney

This independent café is a firm local favourite with their freshly made food and home-baked goods, organic coffee and friendly staff.

#### 11. Old York Road 🗹

The Old York Road is home to independent boutiques, cute cafés and restaurants, handy shops and even a gallery. So whether it's great food, fresh produce, or a pint you're after, this pretty cobbled street has it all. We love local butchers Cleavers and florists Bramble and Willow. Our favourite food and drink spots are Indian street food restaurant Chit Chaat Chai, brunch spot Konnigans, dinky Australian café Brew and local pub The Alma.

#### 12. The Ship 🖄

A well-known spot in south west London for a tipple or ten. They also serve up great food!

### Exploring the area

Mapleton Crescent SW18 is located in leafy Wandsworth, beside the River Wandle and a short walk from the River Thames. There are a whole host of lovely pubs, dinner spots, shops, cinemas and sports facilities right on the doorstep. Just a short walk from local train and tube stations, Mapleton Crescent SW18 has great connections into central London and out to the Surrey Hills.









### Getting out and about

#### Train

Mapleton Crescent SW18 is less than 10 minutes walk from Wandsworth Town Station, from here you can be in:

- Clapham Junction in 3 minutes
- Waterloo in 14 minutes
- Richmond in 14 minutes
- Twickenham in 18 minutes

### East Put

East Putney Underground Station is a 14 minute walk away, where you can jump on the District Line. Be in:

- Parson's Green in 4 minutes
- Earl's Court in 10 minutes
- Paddington in 21 minutes
- Embankment in 26 minutes

#### Bus

Wandsworth is well-connected by bus and from the nearby bus routes you can be in Clapham Junction in 15 minutes, Wimbledon in 20 minutes and Tooting Broadway in 30 minutes:

- 337 or 37 to Clapham Junction Station
- 44 or 270 to Earlsfield Station
- 44 or 270 to Tooting Broadway Station
