



Fantastic transport links have always been Croydon's USP, as trains run to London Bridge, Victoria, Blackfriars and St Pancras International, as far north as Bedford, as far south as Brighton, and it's in the middle of London's only tram network, Ongoing redevelopment means the future is bright; there are hundreds of new flats in freshly built towers or converted office buildings, and Boxpark Croydon - a mecca for foodies, created in shipping containers - has been instrumental in introducing a hipster edge to the area.
